

Long Point Waterfowl's

Research and Education Centre



Long Point Waterfowl established the Research and Education Centre near Turkey Point in 2007. The five main buildings located on this 40 acre property provide seasonal and year-round accommodation and office space for Long Point Waterfowl staff, students, technicians and volunteers.

The Long Point area is home to many local and regional conservation, education, and research based organizations. Based on this and the lack of hotels and conference centers in the region, Long Point Waterfowl is pleased to invite other individuals and organizations to use the facility. Groups that have recently used the facility include Bird Studies Canada, Delta Waterfowl, Ducks Unlimited, Norfolk County, Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters, Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources, and the Simcoe Scouts. The facility is also regularly used for educational field trips and by students and scientists working on various projects.



Since the facility's establishment in 2007, Long Point Waterfowl has utilized rental fees, private donations and government grants to operate and make extensive upgrades to the Research and Education Centre. Long Point Waterfowl also recently established a new interpretive trail and installed educational signs around the property. The new trail system is approximately two kilometers and highlights plants, animals and heritage points present on and around the property. Other recreational facilities include basketball and volleyball courts and a soccer or football field.



The facility has wireless internet, a complete kitchen and a dining hall with seating for 60 people. The conference room can accommodate 100 people, there is lodging space for 50 people and there is ample space to camp.

Buildings were completely renovated in 2010 to include wheel chair access.

Long Point Waterfowl offers nightly (\$30), monthly (\$400) and facility day - use (\$100) rates.

The Long Point Waterfowl Research and Education Centre has facilities to accommodate professional meetings, training workshops and youth activities.
